## 2007 “Hero of the Shareholder Award” Scored Votes U.S. House of Representatives

1. Signature on a letter committing to uphold a presidential veto of a bill on the basis of overspending
2. Signature on a letter committing to uphold a presidential veto of a bill on the basis of a tax increase
3. A vote to retain a supermajority requirement for a tax increase on shareholders (Roll Call #10)
4. A vote to alleviate the anti-shareholder burden of a minimum wage hike (Roll Call #17)
5. A vote against imposing price controls on prescription medicines in Medicare, hurting shareholders who own pharmaceutical stocks (Roll Call #23)
6. A vote against raising taxes on energy companies, hurting shareholders who own utilities and other energy stocks (Roll Call #40)
7. A vote against taking away a worker’s right to a private ballot when deciding on unionization, a policy which would force many public companies into the hands of Big Labor (Roll Call #117)
8. A vote against giving unions the ability to hijack meetings of shareholders (Roll Call #220)
9. A vote against enrolling nearly all children into government-controlled socialized health insurance, a policy which would hurt investors in the health insurance sector (Roll Call #786)
10. A vote to enact a Free Trade Agreement between the United States and Peru, opening up markets in that nation for U.S. goods and services (Roll Call #1060)
